**Board of Regents Scholarship**

**\*APPLICATION DEADLINE: MAY 1**

## Eligibility

Baker College provides tuition scholarships to high school graduates who have achieved a cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.50 (on a 4.0 scale) and a 20-23 ACT Composite score, or a 3.5 G.P.A. (on a 4.0 scale) testing into one or less Developmental Education Courses (determined through Baker College Compass Assessment), or an ACT Composite of 24 or higher (contact the admissions Office with any questions). Scholarship applications must be submitted based on academic performance (G.P.A.) through grade 9-11 or through the end of the first semester of the senior year in high school. These scholarships can be worth up to one-half of the cost of the student's tuition for the quarter enrolled and can be used for a total of 16 quarters. Financial need is not a criterion for this award. Total financial aid awards may not exceed the total cost of tuition, books, and residence halls (if applicable).

## Requirements and Guidelines

Recipients are required to enroll as at least half-time students at Baker College and must enter during either the summer or fall quarter following graduation from high school. Recipients must maintain a minimum 3.00 G.P.A. while attending Baker College and enrollment must be continuous with the exception of summer quarter. The award may not be used in conjunction with the Baker College Career Scholarship.

\*Students must meet minimum Baker College entrance requirements in order to use this scholarship.

## How to Apply

High school seniors with a 3.50 G.P.A. and a 20-23 ACT Composite score, or a 3.5 G.P.A. (on a 4.0 scale) testing into one or less Developmental Education Courses (determined through Baker College Compass Assessment), or an ACT Composite of 24 or higher (contact the admissions Office with any questions) interested in becoming candidates should complete the attached application form. Please request a teacher, counselor, or employer to write a letter of recommendation and attach it to your application. A counselor or other high school official must complete the remaining portion of the application and send it to Baker College with a copy of your most recent high school transcript. Send all items from the checklist on the right to the campus you plan to attend.

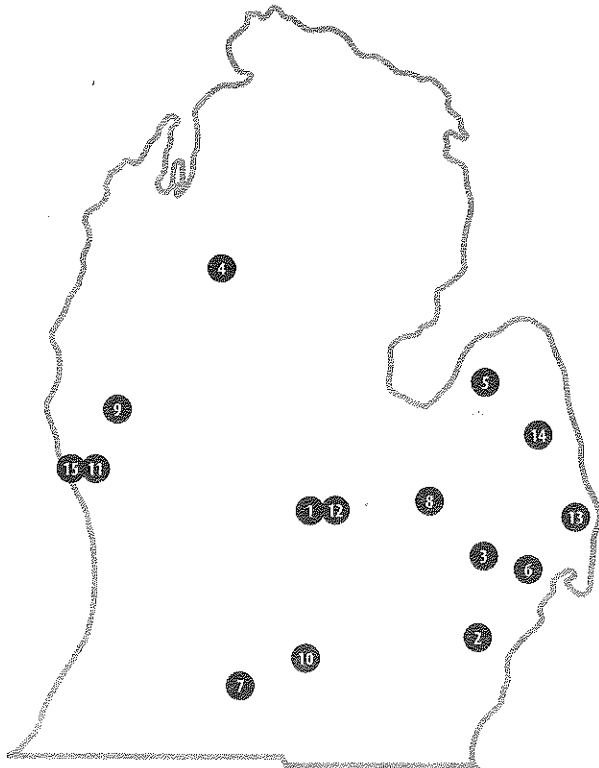
